

Accessing the Entry Level English Reading Tasks

These tasks have been made available through the secure OCR Interchange service so that they are accessible only to centres.

Step 1: access OCR Interchange at the following address: <u>https://interchange.ocr.org.uk</u>

Step 2: enter your login details.
