WHAT IS THE EBACC?

The English Baccalaureate (EBacc) isn't a qualification; it's a performance measure that recognises the achievement of GCSEs at Grades A* to C in five subject areas, or components. These are English, Maths, Humanities, Sciences and Languages. At OCR, we offer GCSEs that count towards the EBacc in all the component areas.

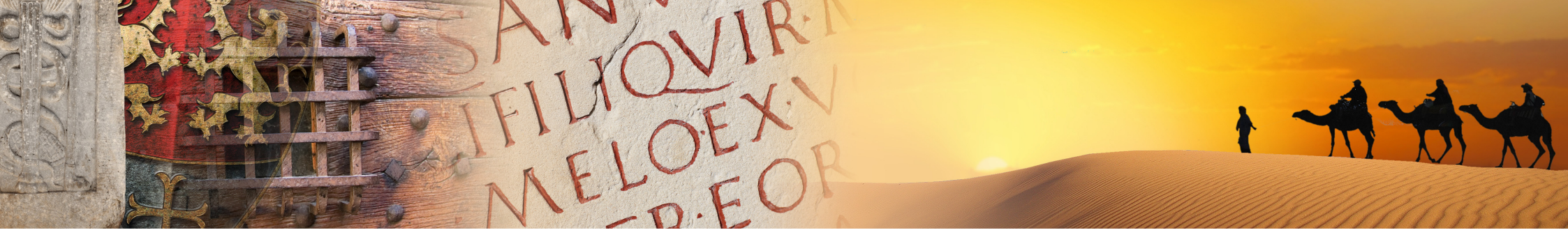
