Subject: New Instructions for conducting examinations for Functional Skills and Cambridge Progression

CHANGE TO REGULATION OF FUNCTIONAL SKILLS AND CAMBRIDGE PROGRESSION EXAMINATIONS

The academic year 2013/14 sees a small but significant change to the administration of OCR's vocational examinations in Functional Skills and Cambridge Progression.

Until September 2013, these examinations were carried out under the regulations contained in the JCQ *Instructions for conducting examinations*.

From September 2013, the JCQ 'ICE' document no longer covers Functional Skills. The range of delivery models across awarding bodies was considered too variable to enable a single document to suffice.

As a consequence, and in line with other awarding bodies, OCR has created its own ICE booklet, which for OCR covers both Functional Skills and Cambridge Progression.
