

#### **Centre Approval Policy for OCR Qualifications**

- 1. Applications to become an OCR Centre will be considered in accordance with the respective requirements for general and/or vocational qualifications to establish whether a prospective centre:
  - can deliver OCR qualifications to the required regulatory and qualification specifications
  - b. has the necessary resources to deliver the assessment to candidates equally, safely and securely
  - has the financial security required to protect OCR's and candidates' interests

# 2. OCR's Centre Approval application forms for Vocational Qualifications require prospective centres to provide

- a. core information in respect of identity, structure and viability
- b. additional information as required by the regulator, OCR and the specific qualification(s)

# 3. OCR will manage the Centre Approval process within the following parameters:

- a. applications for centre approval will be processed in accordance with the requirements of general or vocational qualification(s)
- b. core centre information will be banked so that any future approval will relate only to the additional qualifications the centre is seeking to offer
- c. all information held by OCR will be subject to the requirements of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and the Data Protection Act 1998.

### 4. OCR reserves the right to refuse centre approval to any organisation that:

- a. acts in an unprofessional manner to OCR staff
- b. does not meet OCR's credit requirements
- c. misrepresents OCR and/or its qualifications
- d. is identified with any activity that could adversely affect the reputation of OCR, its products or services
- e. fails to comply with OCR's Terms of Business
- f. does not comply with relevant regulations or is being investigated.

# 5. OCR maintains the right to withdraw centre or qualification approval within the following parameters:

- a. when it is felt necessary to protect the interests of the candidate, the integrity of the qualification, the national qualifications framework or the company reputation
- b. when a centre does not meet its financial obligations to OCR
- c. approval for specific vocational qualifications will be withdrawn if a centre does not enter candidates for a three year period
- d. centre approval for all qualifications will lapse if a centre does not enter candidates for a three year period
- e. centre approval can be withdrawn if a centre does not comply with the published regulatory criteria relating to the qualification offered
- f. fails to comply with OCR's Terms of Business
- 6. Centres have a right to appeal against decisions reached under this policy.
