An overview of this qualification	This qualification assesses your skills in using ICT to carry out straightforward practical tasks in a range of contexts. The qualification is unit-based, which allows you to work towards individual units to gain credits towards the full qualification.		
	To achieve this qualification, you must achieve a total of 9 credits made up of 3 out of 4 units. There is no mandatory unit for this qualification. The optional units focus on different uses of ICT:

	producing graphs from numerical information.		
	This means that the qualification can be tailored to meet your individual needs.		
	However, if you wish to demonstrate skills in fewer applications you will be able to work towards the unit(s) of particular relevance to your own situation. Units of the qualification can also be incorporated into broader courses of study. It is anticipated that you will be able to use the ICT skills you develop in this qualification, in other areas of study and/or in practical workplace situations.		
	Each unit within the qualification is centre-assessed and OCR-moderated. Assessment takes the form of an OCR set on-demand assignment for each unit, which ensures coverage of all of the required knowledge, skills and understanding and allows you to build a portfolio of evidence. It is assessed using OCR set tasks that can be contextualised to suit you. Assessment can take place at any point during the course.		
	As the primary purpose of this qualification is to operate independently and effectively in life, learning and work this qualification will recognise your practical skills in using information technology to carry out straightforward tasks in a range of vocational contexts.
