An overview of this	The OCR Level 3 Certificate in Assessing Vocational Achievement (QCF) is
qualification	part of a suite of qualifications at Levels 3 and consists of units based on the national occupational standards developed by LLUK, the Sector Skills Council for Lifelong Learning in the UK.
	 This qualification covers understanding the principles and practices of assessment, assessing occupational competence in the work environment and assessing vocational skills, knowledge and understanding.
	 This qualification contains the following three mandatory units: Understanding the principles and practices of assessment Assess occupational competence in the work environment Assess vocational skills, knowledge and understanding.
	Each qualification covers all the essential knowledge and understanding that vocational assessors need plus competency based units to cover assessment practice.
	These qualifications are competence-based. This means that they are
	linked to a person's ability to competently perform a range of tasks
	connected with their work and are assessed in the workplace.
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	Minimum amount of vocational learning = 15 credits
	Maximum amount of vocational learning = 15 credits
Entry requirements	There are no specific OCR entry requirements but colleges or training providers may have their own guidelines.
Age restrictions	You must be a minimum of 19 years old.
Is this qualification right for me?	The OCR Level 3 Certificate in Assessing Vocational Achievement (QCF) might be right for you if you are:
	Employed as a trainee assessor of learners in a variety of situations such as in the workplace, a simulated work shop environment or classroom and would like to be a fully qualified assessor of learners both in the classroom and the work environment.
	 This specific size and level of qualification may be right for you if you: would like a course that is tailored to your specific assessment skills requirements; want to further understand assessment strategies and quality
	assurance procedures for QCF qualifications.
	By default you will also achieve the two smaller qualifications the OCR Level 3 Award in Assessing Occupational Competence in the Work



	Environment (QCF) and the OCR Level 3 Award in Assessing Vocationally Related Achievement (QCF). You would choose the take the larger Certificate if your role requires assessment in both settings.
How could I progress from this qualification?	The primary purpose of this qualification is to confirm that you are competent in a specific job role. This qualification will enable you to undertake a learning programme to confirm that you are competent in a role where you have responsibility for assessing learners in a college or in a workplace. It targets the key skills, knowledge and competence that employers would expect of someone working at this level as an assessor.
	Successful achievement of this qualification will provide sufficient evidence that you have acquired the necessary skills and knowledge to enable you to assess within vocational education and training using a range of assessment methods.
	This course will enable you to assess vocational competencies in a wide range of qualifications such as:
