Our new <u>on-line spec-creator tool</u> for our reformed <u>A Level History qualification</u>, first teaching 2015, is now live and ready for use here. Thank you if your centre is the one of the hundreds that has already used it to enter their course details. If you haven't done so yet, please remember, it is **mandatory** to use spec creator to receive confirmation that your chosen combination of units is valid under the new subject criteria (you will need to use spec creator even if you have already checked your unit choices with us by phone or email).

## Spec creator: the benefits for you

Spec creator is quick and easy to use. It gives you the reassurance prior to first teaching that your course overall is valid and it also helps us support you in the delivery of the new A Level. You are able you to sign up to receive information about resources and training for the particular options you've decided to teach, and can opt to be put in contact with other history departments teaching the same options.

## Assessing the new specification

A key feature of our new specification is the introduction of separate examination papers for each topic – again, something you've asked for in the past.
