

Qualification title: OCR Level 3 Cambridge Technical Certificate in Business

Who is the OCR Level 3 Cambridge Technical Certificate in Business for?

This qualification is for you if you're 16 years old or over and want to study business.

This qualification will provide you with the opportunity to develop an understanding of the business environment and to focus on a specific aspect of business through applied learning.

There are no formal entry requirements for this qualification, but, ideally, you will typically have or be working towards GCSEs at grade 4/grade C or above including maths and English.

What does this qualification cover?

You will take the mandatory unit, The business environment, which is an externally assessed unit, and one optional unit.

The mandatory unit will give you an understanding of the wider external contexts in which businesses operate and of internal business functions and their interdependencies. The unit will allow you to appreciate how legal, financial, ethical and resource constraints can affect business behaviour and the influence that different stakeholders can have and how businesses must respond.

The optional units cover a wide range of topics to give you the opportunity to take a unit that is relevant to a specific aspect of business; for example marketing, accounting, human resources or business planning. You will also develop transferable skills that are valued by HE and employers such as communication, planning, teamwork, research and analysis.

What could this qualification lead to?

This qualification, combined with other qualifications, will provide you with the skills, knowledge and understanding to progress into Higher Education (HE) on a business-related programme such as Business, Business Management, Marketing, Business and Finance, Business and Economics and Accounting. It will also allow you to choose non-business related degree programmes.

Is this qualification right for me?

This qualification is part of a suite of Cambridge Technicals in Business at Levels 2 and 3.

You would take an OCR Level 2 Cambridge Technical qualification if you're 16 years old or over and you are looking for a qualification that will enable you to progress into employment in a specific job role.

You would take one of the OCR Level 3 Cambridge Technicals in Business if you wish to progress onto a qualification in the same subject area at a higher level in Higher Education (HE).

Normally, you would choose one of the OCR Level 3 Cambridge Technicals in Business qualifications because you have an interest in the subject area and/or have successfully gained Level 2 qualifications in a similar or related subject.

The qualification is designed to be taken as part of a study programme alongside other vocational qualifications, such as Cambridge Technicals in IT, Laboratory Skills or Sport and Physical Activity and A levels including subjects such as Economics, Maths, Geography, Computer Science, Sociology or Psychology.

There are five sizes of qualification available in the Level 3 Cambridge Technicals in Business suite:

- OCR Level 3 Cambridge Technical Certificate in Business
- OCR Level 3 Cambridge Technical Extended Certificate in Business
- OCR Level 3 Cambridge Technical Foundation Diploma in Business
- OCR Level 3 Cambridge Technical Diploma in Business
- OCR Level 3 Cambridge Technical Extended Diploma in Business

This qualification is the smallest in the suite, similar in size to an AS level, so you would take this alongside your main subjects in your study programme. The units you take provide you with an understanding of the business sector, including working in business, and help build the transferable skills to prepare you to study in a Higher Education Institution, either on a business-related degree course or to support an application for a range of other degree courses, as it would complement the other subjects you take in your study programme.

If you want to take a larger qualification the Extended Certificate, similar in size to one A Level, will provide access to further units to provide breadth of knowledge, understanding and skills in business, again to prepare you to study in a Higher Education Institution either on a business-related degree course or to support an application for a range of other degree courses.

The Foundation Diploma is similar in size to one and a half A levels and will give you a broad understanding of business without specialising in a specific business function. It would also prepare you to study relevant business degrees in a HE institution.

The Diploma is a larger qualification, similar in size to two A levels, which gives you the flexibility to take other qualifications, vocational or academic. The Diploma allows you to tailor your learning to a specific area in the business sector by selecting a specialist pathway (marketing or accounting). It will prepare you to study relevant business degrees in a HE institution. It would also prepare you to move onto an apprenticeship programme in business where you could continue to study.

The Extended Diploma is the largest qualification, similar in size to three A levels. It is taken in two years and will form your complete study program. The Extended Diploma will provide you with the breadth of business knowledge, subject specific skills, understanding and transferable skills to progress to a business degree programme in a HE institution. You could also choose a non-related degree programme or an apprenticeship programme in business where you could continue to study.
