Greg said that the CKP is an important qualification that enables learners to build up a "great knowledge of policing when they start in the job... they'll have been taught the important elements of policing and the responsibilities of a serving officer."

The qualification's mandatory for police forces including the Met (which is the largest) as well as Cheshire, Hertfordshire, South Wales, Surrey and Thames Valley, and is accepted by a number of others. It's fully supported by the College of Policing.
