





### **INSTRUCTIONS TO TEACHERS**

#### Administration

- 1 These tasks are CONFIDENTIAL material until 6 May and must be kept locked away when not in use. Copies must not be removed from the Examination room.
- 2 The tasks must be carried out under Examination conditions. The time allowed must be faithfully adhered to.
- If necessary, the Centre may transcribe or transpose the stimuli to suit the needs of the candidate. In such cases, the transcribed or transposed version must be submitted with the candidate's work.

## **Conduct of the Creative Task**

Teachers should refer to pages 27 and 28 of the specification booklet.

- 1 Hand the candidate a copy of the Creative Task. If requested, play or read any or all of the stimulus once.
- 2 The candidate will select one of the stimuli, and may then request this stimulus to be played or read twice. The stimulus may be recorded for the candidate in any format.
- 3 The candidate then has 45 minutes to prepare and communicate the composition using this stimulus. The candidate may record part or all of the work during this time.
- 4 Instrument(s), technology, including computer, and audio recorder may be used.
- 5 The centre must complete a Creative Task Cover Sheet for **each** candidate.
- **6** When all candidates have completed the Task for this series, the work and the coversheets must be sent immediately to the examiner.
