Question 4 (Page 3)

The question states "<u>Agenor Cadmo</u> dixit. 'ego sum tristissimus. tu <u>debes</u> <u>Europam</u> <u>quaerere</u>' (lines 2-3): pick out and translate the Latin word which tells you how Cadmus felt."

The question should read "<u>Agenor Cadmo</u> dixit. 'ego sum tristissimus. tu <u>debes</u> <u>Europam guaerere</u>' (lines 2-3): pick out and translate the Latin word which tells you how Agenor felt."

Please cross out "Cadmus" and replace with "Agenor".
