

Script for teacher to follow

Look at the pictures of a classroom in a German school. I will point to three things in the pictures and name them in German. I'll say each one twice. Then you are to repeat each German word after me.

We will do one item as a practice example.

Example The example is: Heft [pause] Heft

Now we'll begin.

[The teacher may point to each item as well as saying it.]

Item 1

Buch (Pause and repeat)

Item 2

Lehrer (Pause and repeat)

Item 3

Schultasche (Pause and repeat)

Now I'd like you to name TWO OTHER items in the pictures.

They can be any other items you like from anywhere in the pictures. You must name them in **German**. Start when you're ready.

[If necessary, the teacher should give the candidate one additional try at saying each word, by saying, for example: *Noch einmal* or *wie bitte*? The teacher may also like to point out each item as s/he recognises it.]

I will now ask you 5 questions about school. Listen carefully and answer the questions in German.

[Note: The teacher is encouraged to give candidates an additional chance to communicate a valid response to each task, by asking them to repeat or by rephrasing as necessary. Teachers are reminded that candidates do not need to choose their answers from the examples given.]

1.	TEACHER: Was ist dein Lieblingsfach?	
	CANDIDATE: Gives a suitable subject.	[1]
2.	TEACHER: Wann ist die Mittagspause?	
	CANDIDATE: Gives an appropriate time.	[1]
3.	TEACHER: Wo iβt du zu Mittag?	
	CANDIDATE: Gives any appropriate answer.	[1]
4.	TEACHER: Hast du einen Job?	
	CANDIDATE: Gives an appropriate answer.	[1]
5.	TEACHER: Wann arbeitest du?	
	CANDIDATE: Gives an appropriate answer.	[1]

GENERIC GUIDELINES	
1 mark per question for every valid and relevant response that would be understood by a sympathetic German speaker who knows no English.	
Very short answers, even a single word, are acceptable for the mark. The teacher is encouraged sympathetically to repeat or rephrase once per question in order to elicit the required information from the candidate.


