

Private Candidates – routes to results summer 2020



Schools and colleges need to generate a centre assessment grade for you and to put you in a rank order for each subject, before exam boards can give you a GCSE, AS or A Level result. Schools need to have seen sufficient evidence to do this. For private candidates, they may not have access to the full range of evidence, so there are some other options.

This summarises how private candidates may receive results in summer 2020:





The centre will have to make a judgement as to whether they are confident to provide a submission on your behalf. This must be based on existing evidence generated through your period of study. Any other centre will have to seek permission from their respective exam board to make a submission on your behalf. The centre will need to submit details of the process of validation that they intend to employ. You may have to pay a fee for this service.

If another centre is not able to support your entry, then unfortunately you cannot be awarded a grade this summer. You may have an opportunity to take an exam this autumn or in summer 2021.
