

CAMBRIDGE NATIONALS GRADE AND RANK ORDER REPORTS

We have provided some additional information to help you understand how we have calculated your students' results, and the data we have used in the calculation. We used a process to standardise grades which is based on principles outlined by Ofqual and similar to that developed by Ofqual for GCSEs and A Levels (see our [infographic](#) for more detail).

We have provided some data at both centre and candidate level, which is described below.

Centre level data

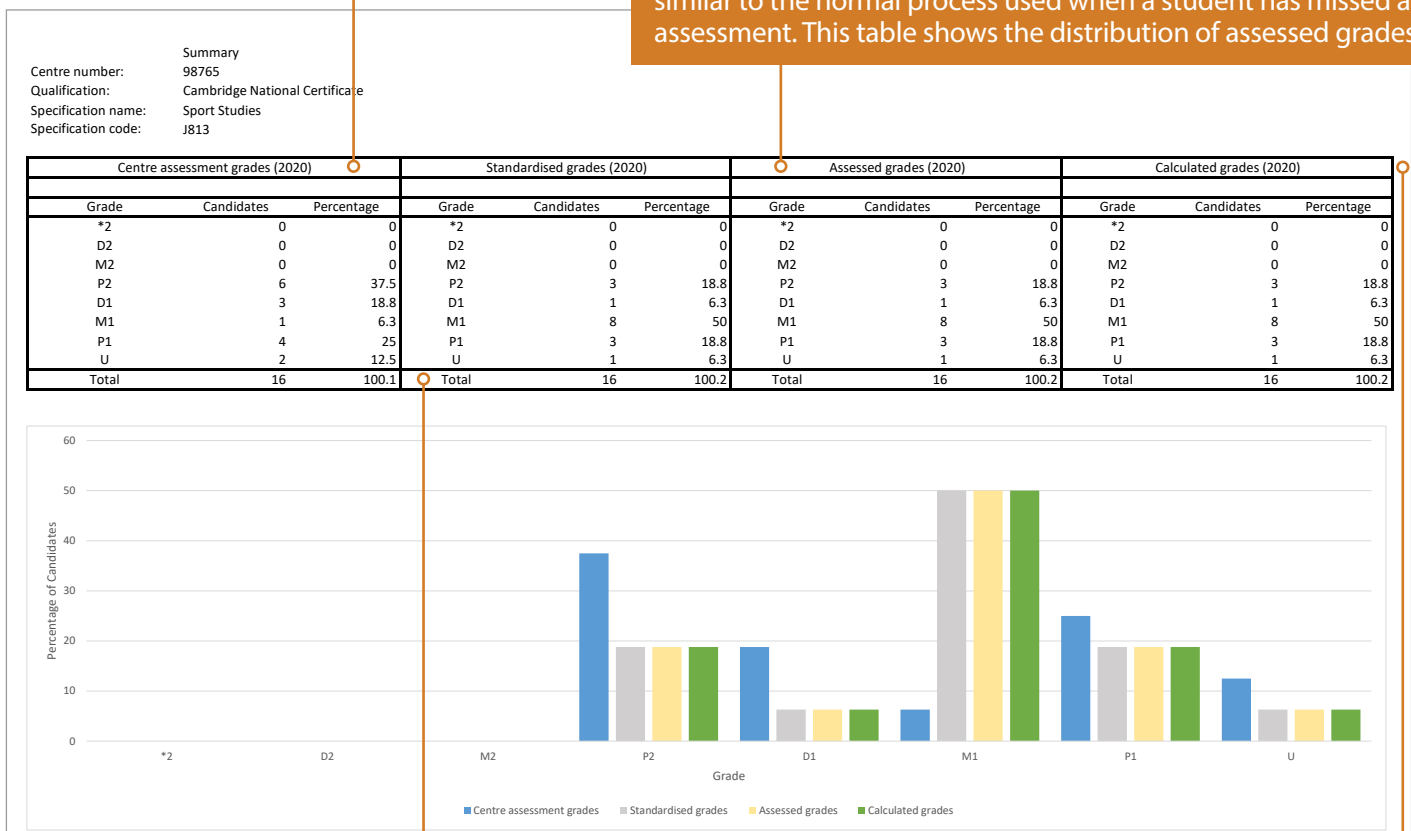
The centre level data tab shows you the distribution of grades for your centre for each source of evidence used to calculate your students' grades (listed below). We have presented the information as tables and a graph to make the calculation of your students' grades easier to understand.

Centre assessment grades (2020)

This shows the distribution of centre assessment grades which you submitted.

Assessed grades (2020)

Where your students had already completed some units towards the qualification, we used the results from these units to calculate an assessed grade for each student. We used a process similar to the normal process used when a student has missed an assessment. This table shows the distribution of assessed grades.



Standardised centre assessment grades (2020)

We 'standardised' your centre assessment grades using your centre's results in recent years (where available), taking into account the size of your entry. This table shows the distribution of standardised centre assessment grades.

Calculated grades (2020)

We combined the standardised centre assessment grades with the assessed grades (where available) for each student to calculate the final grade. We weighted the assessed grades more heavily when a student had taken more units (e.g. 75% of the weighting vs 25%). This table shows the distribution of the final calculated grades for your centre. These are the results that will appear on your students' certificates.
