

Your guide to the changes for 2021

Following an [Ofqual consultation in July 2020](#), we made changes to a number of our qualifications. These changes would have applied to the summer 2021 examinations, had they gone ahead. After a [further consultation](#), Ofqual confirmed the changes will now apply to the autumn 2021 examinations.

Overview of changes for A Level Geography (H481)

Students taking A Level Geography in autumn 2021 will:

- **Not** be required to submit the non-exam assessment (NEA).
- Centres do **not** need to sign a Fieldwork Statement confirming that fieldwork has taken place over at least four days and in relation to processes in both physical and human geography.

A Level Geography (H481) for autumn 2021

Students must complete components 01 to 03 to be awarded an A Level in geography in autumn 2021. There are no changes to the specification content (topics to be delivered) or the geographical skills for assessment in 2021.

<i>Fieldwork written statement</i>	Centres do not need to complete this form to confirm that they have undertaken 4 days of geographical fieldwork, including in relation to processes in both physical and human geography.
