Script for teacher to follow

Look at the picture of the clown.

I will point to three things in the picture and name them in French. I'll say each one twice. Then you are to repeat each French word after me.

We will do one item as a practice example.

Example

The example is: *Main* [pause] *Main*

Now we'll begin.

[The teacher may point to each item as well as saying it.]

Item 1

Bouche (Pause and repeat)

Item 2

Jambe (Pause and repeat)

Item 3

Cheveux (Pause and repeat)

They can be any other parts of the body you like from anywhere in the picture. You must name them in **French**. Start when you're ready.

[If necessary, the teacher should give the candidate one additional try at saying each word, by saying, for example: *Répète, s'il te plaît*. The teacher may also like to point out each item as s/he recognises it.]

Part 3**Role-play****Home life**

We are now going to do the role-play on the page 3 of your Candidate's sheets.

You are talking to your friend, who asks you about your home life.
Listen carefully and answer the questions in French.

[Note: The teacher is encouraged to give candidates an additional chance to communicate a valid response to each task, by asking them to repeat or by rephrasing as necessary.
Teachers are reminded that candidates do not need to choose their answers from the examples given.]

I'll play the part of your friend and I'll start the conversation.

1. TEACHER: Comment est ta chambre?
CANDIDATE: Says what his/her bedroom is like (e.g. big or small or modern or nice)? [1]
2. TEACHER: Qu'est-ce qu'il y a dans ta chambre?
CANDIDATE: Names one item in his/her bedroom. [1]
3. TEACHER: Que fais-tu le matin?
CANDIDATE: Says what s/he does in the morning. [1]
4. TEACHER: Et le soir?
CANDIDATE: Says what s/he does in the evening. [1]
5. TEACHER: Que fais-tu pour aider à la maison?
CANDIDATE: Names one job s/he does to help at home. [1]
6. TEACHER: Merci. Au revoir.

Very short answers, even a single word, are acceptable for the mark. The teacher is encouraged sympathetically to repeat or rephrase once per question in order to elicit the required information from the candidate.
