





Scenario

Karen is in year 13 and wants to become a Microsoft Professional Server Administrator. She will require sufficient Microsoft vendor units to achieve the MCITP: Server Administrator Qualification. She will be doing this as part of her level 3 Diploma in ICT Systems and Principles for IT Professionals.

She will need to achieve a total of 48 credits of which 29 must be at level 3.

The mandatory units include:

- Unit 2 Customer Care level 3 (7 credits)
- Unit 4 Management and Prioritisation of own Schedule level 3 (8 credits)

The optional units will include:

- Unit 90 Configuring Windows Server 2008 Active Directory 70-640 level 3 (13 credits)
- Unit 92 Configuring Windows Server 2008 Network Infrastructure 70-642 level 3 (11 credits)
- Unit 144 Windows Server 2008, Server Administrator 70-646 level 3 (11 credits)

This will give her the required number of credits to achieve the qualification.

Once the qualification has been completed, Karen will have achieved 2 qualifications, one being an industry standard qualification.
