- Candidates should spend up to 5 hours completing each task.

You have been asked:

• to produce a shape that is suitable for children's toys.

You will need to:

- produce a plan

- evaluate your work.

Strand 3 - Database skills:

You work for a company that hires out classic cars. The company holds the details of the different cars it has for hire. Hardeep wants to hire a classic car for his brother's wedding in the summer.

You have been asked:

- to select a range of cars that would be suitable and provide reports in different formats dependent on:
 - price
 - car type
 - colour.

You will need to:

- produce a plan
- evidence your progress
- evaluate your work/strengths/weaknesses.

Strand 4 - Digital Imaging skills:

You work for a newspaper.

You have been asked:

• to create an image for an article the newspaper is running on cars.

You will need to:

- produce a plan
- evidence your progress
- evaluate your work/strengths/weaknesses.

Strand 5 - Spreadsheet skills:

You work for a mobile phone shop. The shop holds the details of all mobile phones sold by each sales person in a spreadsheet.

You have been asked:

- to update the spreadsheet:
 - to include new information
 - to change existing information.
- use the spreadsheet to find out:
 - the total sales for each salesperson
 - the grand total of all sales.

You will need to:

- produce a plan
- evidence your progress
- evaluate your work/strengths/weaknesses.

Strand 6 – Video Editing skills:

You work for an advertising company.

You have been asked:

• to create a short video for a drinks promotion using still images and video.

You will need to:
