ICT Professional Competence (PROCOM) (QCF)

Since the publication of the *OCR Admin Guide: Vocational Qualifications 2010/11*, a number of changes have been made to the PROCOM qualifications. These are outlined below. When making entries/claims, you **must** use the information within this addendum rather than that contained within the admin guide.

Withdrawn qualifications

The qualifications below are being withdrawn. Both these qualifications are now only available for **certification only** until the dates shown below. The rules of combination remain unchanged for existing entries.
